Driving Directions from I-90

From I-90, take Exit 22. Go north on the Preston/Fall City Road for about 4.5 miles.

Word to the wise - Between the Shell Station / Preston Playfields until you are all the way through city of Preston, the speed limit is 25 mph. They're very aggressively on the lookout for speeders. The speed limit increases to 45 mph once you've cleared Preston.

Turn right at S.E. David Powell Road and go 2.5 miles. You're now at the electric gate - your directions continue on the second page.

Driving Directions from the Redmond - Fall City Road

Take Redmond Way east to Fall City. At the east end of downtown Fall City, turn south (right) onto the Preston - Fall City road. Go approximately 1/3 mile, then turn left onto SE David Powell Road and go 2.5 miles. your directions continue on the second page.

Driving Directions from North Bend

Take Highway 202 west to Fall City. At the east end of downtown Fall City, turn south (left) onto the Preston - Fall City road. Go approximately 1/3 mile, then turn left onto SE David Powell Road and go 2.5 miles. You're now at the electric gate - your directions continue on the second page.



From Our Gate

Please remember that:

- *This gate will be open for all theater performances and other scheduled events.*
- *All members are given a keycard that they can use to access the park at other times.*
- *If you arrive for an event and the gate is closed,*
 - *please **DO NOT** use the gate box to contact any of the property owners.*
 - *please **DO NOT** walk around the gate to walk up the road. Doing so will result in a \$1000 fine.*
 - *please use a **cell phone** to call your event representative **or***
 - *please use a **cell phone** to call the SFFT office at (425) 736-7252.*

Between this gate and our gate is a private easement. The property owners have electronic equipment along the easement to gauge speed and record license plates.

- ***You must drive under 10 mph through the easement.** Driving above 10 mph will result in a \$1000 fine.*
- *You may not stop your vehicle or walk along the easement between the electric gate and our gate at any time. Doing so will result in a \$1000 fine.*
- *You may not walk around the gate and up the easement road to access our park at any time. Doing so will result in a \$1000 fine.*
- *You may never approach any of the individuals, houses or other structures or stop along the easement at any time. Doing so will result in a \$1000 fine.*

Proceed up the road at no more than 10 miles per hour. Once you pass through the second (always open) gate, you're on SFFT property and can moderately increase your speed. After about 100 yard, the road makes a sharp right turn and starts up hill. Continue all of the way to the top of the hill to the parking area.

Do NOT take the spur road that comes up on your left. Due to insurance and public safety restrictions, only SFFT staff and public safety vehicles may use this road. This road is off limits to park visitors and theater patrons at all times.

When leaving the park, remember that the same 10 mph speed limit applies through the easement. If the gate is closed, continue slowly toward the gate. A sensor in the pavement near the gate will detect your car and the gate will open.
